D., 1856 in the county of Fayette in the State of Georgia. I have not remarried since the death of my said husband J. C. Waldron.

My husband the said J. C. Waldron enlisted Military or Naval and served in the Confederate, Co B 5th Fla service of the State of Florida troops during the war between the States of the United States, and he did not desert the Confederate or State service.

I was a resident of the State of Florida on January 1st, 1890 and have since continuously resided in this State, that I do not own property, real or personal to the value of eight hundred dollars.
