

# Widow's Pension Claim

UNDER THE ACT OF 1909

(FORM A.)

On this *10* day of *Augt*, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred

and *Mrs*, personally appeared before me, a *Justice of the Peace* in and for the

County and State aforesaid. *Sarah Melton*

a resident of *Lake City #5* County of *Columbia*

State of Florida, who being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain a pension under the provisions of Chapter 5885, Laws of Florida, approved June 7, 1909.

That she is the widow of *Robert Melton*

who was enlisted under the name of *Robert Melton B*

on the *March* day of *1862*, in Company *B*

*5th* Regiment of the State of *Florida*

and who was honorably discharged at *Home* *Apr*, 186*5*,

on account of *Surrender*

That he also served

That she was lawfully married to the said *Robert*

*Melton* under the name of *Sarah Braucan*

in the County of *Columbia*, State of *Florida*

*Sept*, 1889, in the County of *Columbia* State of *Florida*

That she is a resident of *Columbia* County, Florida, and has continuously resided in

the State of Florida since the *all* day of *May*
