Your letter of the 10th inst. addressed to Hon. Ernest Amos, Comptroller, has been referred to me as the matter about which you write has become part of the records of the State Pension Board.

I am handing herewith statement of property shown on the assessment rolls of Columbia and Pasco Counties in your name. This statement is self explanatory, but I wish to call your attention to the fact that there is no mention of any personal property upon same. Even if the property was assessed at a valuation of only 50 per cent. the full value of the real property only owned by you would be \$8,260.00. If you owned any personal property whatever, it should be added to this amount.
