

Florida, which organization was regularly mustered into the service of the Confederate States of America; that he knows of his own personal knowledge that *Henry Cason* enlisted in Company *"B" 1st Fla Reserve* Regiment of the State of *Fla*, at *White Springs*, in the State of *Florida* on the *April* day of *1864*; that he served faithfully in the said organization until the *May* day of *1865*, when he was HONORABLY DISCHARGED on account of *Close of war*, at *Madison*, in the State of *Florida*, and did not desert the Confederate States service nor take the oath of allegiance to the United States before the close of the war.
